All DePaul undergraduate students who have completed FIN 310 and all of its prerequisites with no final grades in these courses lower than B- are eligible for admission to this program.

For admission to the combined program, applicants must provide the following documents electronically (saved in pdf format) to <u>financefrontdesk@depaul.edu</u> or in-person to the reception desk in DePaul Center suite 5500:

- A completed application submitted to the Finance Department (application fee will be waived),
- A current resume/curriculum vitae summarizing their work experience and educational background, no more than 2 pages in length, and
- A personal statement outlining their personal goals in pursuing the MS degree program, approximately 600 words in length.

The admissions committee may require applicants to participate in a personal interview.

Please note: meeting the minimum requirements does not guarantee admission to the program.
