#### Scholarship Criteria\*

- Enrolled as a graduate student, full-time or part-time (minimum of 2 classes in each Fall and Spring Semester) in a commercial real estate program at DePaul University, Chicago; Minimum 3.0 GPA
- 35 and Under

\*All applicants who meet the above criteria will receive complimentary attendance to a 2020 NAIOP Chicago program.

#### **Scholarship Expectations**

- Attendance at a minimum of 1 NAIOP Chicago breakfast meeting, including interacting with DL Connector. (NAIOP Chicago young professional)
- Attendance at a minimum of 2 NAIOP Chicago Developing Leaders Events for Young Professionals (*Typically held downtown in the evenings*)
- Attend the 2020 NAIOP Chicago Awards for Excellence Dinner (November 12, 2020)
- Participation in the 2021 NAIOP Chicago Mentorship Program, including attendance at the Kick-Off and Closing Reception (Consists of quarterly meetings with a senior real estate mentor scheduled at mutually agreeable times / location)
